Economically, McGraw-Hill's pricing models—often tied to district-wide licensing—have reinforced dependency on proprietary software, embedding publishing firms within the infrastructure of public education systems. This creates long-term lock-in effects, where schools become reliant on continuous updates, data feeds, and technical support, effectively transforming curricula into recurring service contracts.
