The initiative also emerged from a transnational network of reform: Finland's inquiry-based approach, Singapore's mastery learning, and Canada's culturally responsive math curricula all informed its design. Yet Oxford's version distinguishes itself through its integration of affective learning—emphasizing curiosity, resilience, and enjoyment as co-equal to accuracy and speed. Oxford's model, tested in real classrooms, positions the UK to capture a significant share of this future talent pool. Yet the geopolitical implications extend beyond national competitiveness. The initiative intersects with broader debates about educational sovereignty and equity in a globalized world.
