A 2021 study by the Global Education Monitoring Report estimated that producing and delivering 1,000 physical spelling worksheets costs approximately \$25–\$40, a sum prohibitive for underfunded ministries of education.

This disparity fuels a parallel economy of open educational resources (OER). Platforms like UNICEF’s Learning Passport and UNESCO’s Global Education Coalition have scaled free, downloadable worksheets in multiple languages, often funded by international aid. In Kenya, for instance, Room to Read produces 500,000+ worksheets annually in Swahili, Hindi, and local dialects, funded through donor partnerships and government grants. Yet grassroots initiatives like Ghana's 'Spelling for All' project use mobile printing units to deliver localized worksheets, demonstrating adaptive resilience. In Europe, the European Commission's 'Digital Education Action Plan' promotes hybrid models: print worksheets complement digital platforms, ensuring inclusion for students without consistent internet. This contrasts with the U.S., where school districts like Chicago Public Schools distribute physical packets to students without home devices, recognizing digital equity as a prerequisite for access.
