Geopolitically, **One Hundred Years of Solitude** arrived at a pivotal moment. The 1960s saw the Cold War's ideological battlegrounds deepen in Latin America: U.S.-backed coups, revolutionary uprisings, and state terror. García Márquez, by then a committed leftist and close associate of Fidel Castro, infused the novel with a critical view of imperialism and neocolonial dependency. The banana massacre—banished from official history—becomes a central trauma, mirroring real atrocities like the 1928 Ciénaga Massacre. The novel's portrayal of foreign intervention, corporate greed, and clerical complicity resonated with readers across the Global South, positioning it as more than literature: a counter-narrative to
