As colonial powers extended into Africa, Asia, and the Americas, the body became both a site of study and a symbol of cultural difference. Medical illustrators accompanied explorers, surgeons, and administrators, producing visual records that framed non-European bodies through a colonial lens. In Spanish and Portuguese colonies, anatomical knowledge was often extracted—bodies of indigenous peoples, enslaved Africans, and local populations dissected not only for science but as part of dehumanizing racial hierarchies. The **libro dibujo** thus became a tool of epistemic violence. This effort to decolonize anatomy reflects broader struggles over medical identity in a globalized world. These regional variations demonstrate that *libros dibujo* are not monolithic—they are living, contested texts shaped by local histories, power dynamics, and epistemic choices.
