By the late 18th century, mechanization began to displace skilled artisans, yet hand-sewing persisted in premium markets, preserving a hierarchy of quality and value. What Shaeffer reveals is that the true transformation didn't begin with the sewing machine, but with colonial trade networks that supplied raw cotton—largely from enslaved labor in the American South and later indentured labor in British India—fueling early garment production. This foundational exploitation set a precedent: the global supply chain, even in the 19th century, was built on unequal exchange, a dynamic that persists today. The 20th century accelerated this arc. Post-WWII, the U.S. and Western Europe pioneered mass-produced ready-to-wear, but the real seismic shift occurred in the 1970s and 1980s, when multinational corporations began offshoring production to East and Southeast Asia. Shaeffer's fieldwork in Dhaka's garment districts and Jakarta's industrial zones reveals a paradox: while Bangladesh and Vietnam emerged as hubs of low-cost labor, the design, branding, and retail control remained concentrated in Paris, New York, and Shanghai. This geographic dislocation of labor from consumption is not accidental—it is the economic logic of “just-in-time” manufacturing, optimized for rapid turnover and razor-thin margins. Shaeffer's interviews with factory managers and union leaders expose the human cost embedded in this model. In a 2022 visit to a Thai garment workshop, she documented a 12-hour workday with minimal breaks, where machinery noise drowns out

conversations, and safety protocols are often bypassed under pressure to meet delivery deadlines. The 2013 Rana Plaza collapse, which killed over 1,100 workers, is not a historical footnote but a recurring vulnerability—Shaeffer shows how structural inequalities persist: fragmented subcontracting, weak labor enforcement, and the relentless cost-cutting that prioritizes profit over prevention. Yet, the story is not solely one of exploitation. Shaeffer’s deep analysis of technological integration reveals a counter-narrative of innovation. Automated cutting rooms, AI-driven pattern optimization, and 3D knitting have reduced waste and improved precision, particularly in high-end brands like Stella McCartney and Patagonia, which leverage “seamless” techniques to minimize fabric scraps. In Japan, companies like Shima Seiki have pioneered robotic knitting that mimics hand-stitched complexity, redefining speed without sacrificing quality. These developments suggest a future where automation augments rather than replaces human skill—if governed by ethical labor standards. The geopolitical dimension is equally critical. Shaeffer maps the shifting alliances of textile production: China’s dominance in synthetic fibers, India’s growing role in digital printing, and the U.S.-led push to reshore production amid rising trade tensions. The Inflation Reduction Act and EU’s Carbon Border Adjustment Mechanism are reshaping investment flows, incentivizing “nearshoring” to Mexico, Poland, and Indonesia. Yet, these policies risk deepening fragmentation: as nations weaponize trade to secure domestic manufacturing, the very fluidity that made global supply chains efficient becomes a vulnerability—especially in times of crisis, as seen during the pandemic’s disruption of maritime logistics. Economically, sewing remains the backbone of employment in the Global South, employing over 60 million workers—predominantly women—whose wages stagnate while global fashion’s revenue exceeds \$1.5 trillion. Shaeffer’s data-driven examination shows that despite rising consumer awareness of sustainability, only 1% of garments are recycled into new textiles, revealing a systemic failure to close the loop. The circular economy model, though promising, is hindered by technical barriers: dyeing processes remain water-intensive, and mechanical recycling degrades fiber quality, requiring breakthroughs in chemical recycling and biodegradable fibers. Expert perspectives converge on a central tension: sewing’s future hinges on reconciling speed with sustainability, automation with dignity. Dr. Amara Ndiaye, a textile sociologist at Sciences Po, argues that “the true innovation lies not in machines, but in reimagining human roles—transforming workers
