This could democratize spiritual expression, empowering marginalized voices to shape narratives long dominated by elite institutions. Yet challenges remain. How to preserve depth amid the velocity of digital content? How to ensure diverse, inclusive representations rather than reinforcing dominant tropes? How to protect the integrity of spiritual inquiry from surveillance capitalism and algorithmic manipulation? Since the 1990s, the government has invested heavily in cultural industries, recognizing their potential to project national identity and influence. Industry Impact: From Gatekeepers to Guilds

Voices from academia and media critique illuminate the deeper significance of this phenomenon. Dr. Kang Min-jun, a media theorist at Yonsei University, describes the manhwa as “a digital ritual of collective introspection.” He argues: “In an era of fragmented identities,
