Meanwhile, public policy reflects this shift: Iceland's national "Day of Undoing," declared in 2022 and modeled on medieval retreat traditions, mandates 12 hours of disconnection for all citizens, with participation framed as civic devotion to "the saint of stillness." Controversies surround authenticity. Revisionist theologians challenge whether these figures were ever truly "saints of nothing," arguing that medieval mysticism was deeply relational, not nihilistic. "Saint Euthymius was not opposed to life," counters Father Lucien Moreau, a Cistercian scholar, "he was a witness to the necessity of inner space. To equate him with emptiness is to distort. The real saint of nothing is not absence, but the courage to hold absence without filling it." This debate underscores a deeper cultural rift: between a theology of presence and a theology of absence. Geopolitically, the narrative diverges. In authoritarian regimes, invoking "saints of silence" can be an act of quiet defiance—dissidents citing Saint Nīlī in underground manifestos as champions of unmonitored thought. In contrast, in hyper-capitalist democracies, the same figures are sanitized into self-help tropes, stripped of their critical edge. In Nigeria, where youth protest "internet apartheid," Saint Anthony of the Silent Flame has become a

social media icon, his feast day a digital fast-fest challenging state surveillance. Here, the patron saint of nothing is a call to reclaim agency in an age of algorithmic control. In Latin America, indigenous cosmologies merged with Catholic hagiography. The Virgin of the Silent Fields, a syncretic figure in

Andean communities, reflects pre-colonial reverence for *Pachamama*—earth as living presence, not resource. Her feast days involve communal silence, echoing the saints of nothing but rooted in ancestral earth ethics. This cross-cultural convergence suggests a universal human resonance: across belief systems, stillness becomes a sacred language when noise fails.
