Moreover, she sees a generational shift. Younger journalists are less bound by traditional media hierarchies, more willing to leverage decentralized networks

and open-source intelligence. This democratization, however, demands new ethical guardrails—particularly in an age where misinformation spreads faster than fact-checking.
