Post-colonial nations grappled with balancing global standards and local identity, leading to hybrid curricula. In Nigeria, for example, E-based phonics materials blend English with Yoruba and Hausa phonology, resisting cultural erasure while building literacy. Today, digital free printables have become instruments of soft power. Western ed-tech firms export standardized E worksheets to emerging markets, often bypassing local educators. While this democratizes access, it risks imposing external literacy norms—prioritizing Anglo-American vocabulary over cultural relevance. A 2021 study in South Africa found that 43% of free E worksheets used Western-themed contexts (e.g., “bedroom,” “bedtime”), alienating learners in rural communities where daily life centers on agriculture or community.
