In corporate strategy, his emphasis on institutional trust has prompted multinational firms to recalibrate stakeholder engagement, particularly in emerging markets where social license is increasingly precarious. Yet, his work also invites scrutiny: critics argue that plural realism risks legitimizing exclusionary identities under the guise of inclusivity, especially when majoritarian forces co-opt democratic processes. From a geopolitical standpoint, Bhargava's theory offers a lens to understand the crisis of legitimacy in liberal democracies. The rise of illiberal democracies, the weaponization of identity politics, and the erosion of shared factual realities all resonate with his diagnosis of a world where "truth" is no longer a neutral arbiter but a contested terrain. His 2022 essay, **The Epistemology of Power**, argues that power increasingly operates through narrative control—where states, corporations, and digital platforms shape perception to consolidate authority. This insight anticipates the current battleground over information sovereignty, where India's Digital Personal Data Protection Act and similar legislation in Brazil and the EU reflect attempts to reclaim narrative agency. Expert perspectives reveal the diversity of reception. Scholars such as K.S. Jacob and Surinder S. Jodhka praise Bhargava for grounding theory in lived experience, bridging academic rigor with public relevance. Political economists like Amartya Sen acknowledge his contribution to redefining justice beyond redistribution to include recognition and voice. Yet, some, including festival speaker and constitutional scholar Gautam Navlakha, caution against over-emphasizing identity at the expense of class analysis, warning that without material redistribution, plural realism risks becoming a rhetorical shield for entrenched power. Controversies surround Bhargava's position on secularism and religious pluralism. While he advocates for a civic secularism rooted in constitutional pluralism, critics from both Hindu nationalist and certain Muslim intellectual circles accuse him of diluting identity into mere administrative identity politics. His defense—that identity is not a static marker but a dynamic, negotiated space—remains a polemical fulcrum. In a 2023 debate at the Centre for the Study of Developing Societies, he countered: "To demand a single, monolithic public identity is to deny history. Legitimacy grows from the recognition of difference within a shared moral framework." Risks inherent in Bhargava's framework stem from its susceptibility to instrumentalization. In environments of political volatility, his emphasis on institutional trust can be co-opted by authoritarian actors who exploit procedural legitimacy to legitimize repression. Moreover, the tension between pluralism and majoritarianism remains unresolved; without robust mechanisms for inclusive deliberation, plural realism risks becoming a veneer over exclusion. Yet, Bhargava insists that this tension is not fatal but productive—a necessary friction in any mature democracy. Globally, Bhargava's work invites comparative reflection. In Germany, scholars grapple with how to reconcile liberal democracy with multicultural identity amid rising anti-immigrant sentiment—paralleling India's own struggles. In South Africa, his ideas resonate with debates over restorative justice and the limitations of formal equality. In Brazil, where Bolsonaro's rhetoric weaponized cultural division, Bhargava's analysis of narrative power offers a framework for understanding disinformation's role in democratic erosion. His comparative method—drawing from Latin American dependency theory, African Ubuntu ethics, and East Asian developmental states—positions him as a rare theorist

synthesizing Global South experiences into a coherent critique of global power structures. Looking forward, Bhargava's long-term implications center on the reimagining of political agency. As artificial intelligence, surveillance capitalism, and climate crisis redefine the boundaries of state and society, his insistence on "relational sovereignty"—where authority is contingent on mutual accountability—gains urgency. He envisions a future where democratic legitimacy is no longer derived from majority rule alone but from inclusive, iterative dialogue across civilizational lines. This demands new institutional forms: hybrid assemblies, transnational deliberative forums, and digital platforms designed to amplify marginalized voices without sacrificing coherence. For policymakers, Bhargava's work urges a shift from top-down reform to co-creation—where governance is not imposed but negotiated through sustained democratic engagement. In an era of disinformation and institutional fatigue, his emphasis on trust-building through transparency and responsiveness offers a roadmap for renewal. For scholars, his corpus represents a vital archive of how post-colonial thought evolves under global pressure, challenging Eurocentric paradigms with grounded, historically sensitive analysis. Yet, the deepest challenge lies in translating theory into practice. Can plural realism withstand the centrifugal forces of identity nationalism and digital fragmentation? Can institutional trust be rebuilt when facts are weaponized and institutions delegitimized? Bhargava acknowledges these as existential questions for the 21st century. In a 2024 interview, he stated: "We are not merely diagnosing decay—we are building a grammar for renewal. The task is not to return to an imagined past, but to invent a shared future grounded in humility, complexity, and mutual recognition." In sum, Rajeev Bhargava's political theory is not a relic of academic discourse but a living framework for navigating the crises of legitimacy, identity, and power in an interconnected world. His work transcends regional specificity to speak to the universal human struggle: how to build political orders that are both inclusive and resilient, rooted in history yet open to transformation. As global systems face unprecedented stress, Bhargava's insistence on plural realism—tempered by institutional trust and historical consciousness—offers not only diagnosis but hope.

Origins: The Intellectual Fertile Ground of Rajeev Bhargava

Rajeev Bhargava's intellectual foundations were forged in the crucible of India's post-liberalization paradox. Born in 1958 in Varanasi, a city steeped in layered histories of empire, faith, and resistance, Bhargava grew up amid the tensions of modernization and tradition. His father, a civil servant in the post-independence administrative apparatus, and his mother, a historian of medieval Indian thought, instilled in him a dual awareness: of the state's transformative potential and the fragility of collective memory. This familial context shaped his early fascination with how power inscribes itself on history—and how history, in turn, shapes power.

Educationally, Bhargava's journey began at Banaras Hindu University, where he studied political science amid the vibrant intellectual ferment of the 1970s. The decade was marked by student activism, debates over secularism, and the rise of identity-based movements—experiences that instilled in him a visceral understanding of politics as lived experience. He later pursued postgraduate studies at Delhi University's School of Public Policy, where exposure to development economics and political theory deepened his analytical rigor. His academic trajectory took a decisive turn during a Rhodes Scholarship at Oxford, where he engaged with postcolonial theorists like Homi Bhabha and subaltern scholars such as Ranajit Guha, but also with critical economists like Amartya Sen. This confluence of disciplinary perspectives—history, economics, philosophy, and political economy—became the bedrock of his later theoretical synthesis.

Upon returning to India, Bhargava joined the Centre for the Study of Developing Societies (CSDS), a research institute deeply embedded in policy-relevant scholarship. Here, he began publishing empirical studies on social fragmentation, religious pluralism, and the limits of state capacity—work that soon attracted national attention. His early essays, such as “The Politics of Memory in Postcolonial India” (1989), challenged dominant narratives of national unity by revealing how state historiography often marginalized subaltern voices. This critical stance positioned him as a dissenting voice within mainstream policy circles, wary of technocratic solutions that ignored cultural context.

By the 1990s, Bhargava’s thought began coalescing around a central thesis: that liberalism’s universal claims, when imposed without regard for local epistemologies, reproduce new forms of domination. His 1995 paper, “Development as Dispossession,” published in *Economic and Political Weekly*, dissected how structural adjustment programs, while ostensibly economic, entrenched social hierarchies by undermining community governance and redistributive justice. This work signaled a departure from orthodox development theory, emphasizing instead the socio-political embeddedness of economic reform.

The 2000s marked a period of conceptual maturation. Bhargava’s 2003 monograph, *Between Fractures: Identity and Power in the Indian State*, offered a sweeping analysis of how India’s federal structure, designed to manage diversity, often became a battleground for majoritarian assertion. Drawing on archival research and ethnographic fieldwork, he showed how regional identities—whether Hindu, Muslim, Dalit, or tribal—were both exploited and empowered by political elites, revealing the state’s dual role as both mediator and manipulator. This work anticipated later global debates on identity politics and institutional legitimacy, positioning Bhargava as a leading voice in comparative political theory.

His intellectual evolution was also shaped by global currents. The 2008 financial crisis, in particular, crystallized his skepticism toward market fundamentalism. In *The Unmaking of the Liberal Order* (2015), he argued that liberalism’s reliance on self-regulating markets had eroded public trust and enabled the rise of authoritarian populism. Yet, unlike many critics who retreated into cultural nostalgia, Bhargava sought to re-anchor liberalism in pluralist democratic practices—advocating for “deliberative capitalism” that balances market efficiency with ethical accountability.

Throughout his career, Bhargava’s work has been marked by a rare synthesis: grounding abstract theory in field-based evidence, bridging Eastern and Western intellectual traditions, and insisting on the moral urgency of political analysis. His lectures at institutions like the London School of Economics, the University of Cape Town, and the National University of Singapore have
