The program’s structure reflects a deliberate rejection of the “one-size-fits-all” model. This hybrid model—print and digital, analog and digital—mirrors the bifurcated reality of modern classrooms, particularly in regions where internet access remains uneven. Economically, the edition signals a shift in Francophone educational publishing. Sami contributed authentic Japanese dialogue, filtered through French linguistic sensitivity, while Julie ensured cultural fidelity—avoiding exoticism, emphasizing everyday realism. The result was a program that taught grammar not as a set of rules, but as a living, breathing system embedded in human interaction. The French National Agency for Education (ANEP) initially regarded the project with skepticism. Standard curricula emphasized standardized testing and grammatical precision, with little room for “soft” pedagogical methods. Yet early pilot programs in Lyon’s immigrant communities revealed striking outcomes: learners reported higher motivation, deeper retention, and increased confidence in real-world communication. These results, validated through qualitative interviews and longitudinal tracking, convinced skeptics to reconsider. By

2020, the Ministry of National Education, under pressure from evolving demographic realities, began integrating excerpts of **Lire en Jeu** into pilot adult literacy initiatives. The publication of the French edition in 2022—co-published by Éditions de l'Atelier and the Institute for Global Linguistics—marked a formal institutional endorsement. It was not simply a translation, but a cultural adaptation: French readers, unfamiliar with Japanese tea culture or **wabi-sabi**, engaged with annotations, glossaries, and supplementary media that contextualized meaning. This hybrid print-digital model ensured accessibility across socioeconomic strata, a critical factor in France's diverse educational landscape.

Geopolitical and Economic Context: Language as Soft Power and Social Equity

Japan, though not a traditional colonial power, wields growing soft power through its cultural exports—anime, fashion, cuisine, and technological innovation. Japanese language learning has surged worldwide, but demand remains uneven. Without systematic grammar review and phonemic training, learners risk shallow fluency—understanding isolated phrases but struggling with complex syntax.' The program's response has been to refine its structure: weekly mini-lessons on morphology and syntax are embedded within narrative units, ensuring balanced development. Digital tools now offer adaptive quizzes that adjust difficulty based on performance, reinforcing both

comprehension and accuracy.

Controversies, Risks, and Structural Challenges

Some traditionalists argue that its “story-first” method neglects foundational skills, risking a generation of communicative competence without structural mastery.
