training, mentorship, and moral resolve. The art emphasized muscle definition not for shock value, but as a visual language of capability and growth. Her physique was rendered with anatomical precision, muscles defined not as decoration but as evidence of labor, sacrifice, and mastery. Sakura's success catalyzed a wave. Creators across Asia, Latin America, and Europe began crafting narratives where female characters—adventurers, scientists, soldiers, leaders—possessed not only strength but intellectual and emotional depth. The genre rejected the binary: muscle was no longer exclusive to male heroes. It became a symbol of reclaimed identity—women embodying physicality as right, not rebellion. This evolution cannot be divorced from the economic realities of the 21st-century creative economy. In India, publishers like **Rangwali Press** have championed **Kali's Legacy**, a trilogy reimagining Hindu goddesses not as passive deities but as physically formidable warriors trained in martial arts and strategy. The series taps into a resurgent national identity that blends tradition with modernity, positioning female strength as both culturally rooted and globally relevant. Similarly, in Brazil, Afro-Brazilian comic artists weave muscular female characters into narratives of **quilombo** resistance, linking physical power to historical memory of resistance against slavery. Female characters, even in action-oriented works, rarely displayed physical training or muscular definition—such traits were either absent or relegated to sidekicks or villains. The few exceptions, like Tenya Igarashi's *Hana no Tsubomi* (1980s), were anomalies, often criticized for “masculinizing” female forms. The broader industry treated muscular female bodies as incongruent with femininity, reinforcing the idea that strength and softness were mutually exclusive. This erasure extended beyond visuals into narrative structure. Stories centered on women emphasized interpersonal conflict, romantic subplots, or emotional trauma, rarely exploring physical prowess as a narrative engine. When female characters did possess strength, it was often supernatural—gifted by gods or curses—rather than earned through training. Such depictions, while fantastical, still excluded the lived reality of women who trained, built muscle, and asserted physical capability in the real world. The feminist movements of the 1960s and 1970s began to challenge this, but progress in comics was incremental. Underground comix in the 1970s, led by artists like Joann Sfar and Carol Lay, offered glimpses of alternative narratives—female characters using

strength in subversive, non-traditional ways. Yet these remained marginal, excluded from mainstream distribution and critical discourse. It was not until the digital age, with its decentralized platforms and global reach, that the foundation was laid for a systematic reversal.
