Export logistics, governed by international phytosanitary standards and complex certification regimes, often excluded small players. Monique faced not just ecological uncertainty but the bureaucratic weight of export compliance, where a single failed inspection could sink months of harvest. Her advocacy extended beyond technique: she lobbied for policy reforms, including regional trade agreements that prioritized climate-resilient farmers and streamlined certification for small-scale producers. The geopolitical context is critical. Senegal, like many West African nations, sits at the crossroads of climate vulnerability and agricultural potential. The mango rains project became a case study in the region's struggle to leverage agro-biodiversity as a climate adaptation tool. International donors, including the World Bank and the African Development Bank, funded pilot programs, but their emphasis on export-oriented monocultures clashed with Monique's vision of diversified, community-controlled systems. Her resistance to extractive models—where land and labor were optimized for global markets at the expense of local food sovereignty—placed her at odds with powerful stakeholders. Yet her insistence on “sovereign agroecology” resonated across the Global South, influencing policy dialogues at the UNFCCC and the FAO, where she became a vocal proponent of farmer-led innovation. Expert perspectives

reveal the multidimensionality of her impact. This hybrid model challenges the false dichotomy between “local” and “global,” suggesting a path where smallholders command value rather than being marginalized by it. The origins of the mango rains narrative trace back to the late 20th century, when Senegal’s agricultural sector faced a dual crisis: declining soil fertility and erratic rainfall linked to shifting climate patterns. The Niayes region, a narrow coastal strip south of Dakar, became a frontline: once fertile, it now suffers from salinization and desertification, with rainfall decreasing by 15% since 1980. Traditional rain-fed farming, centered on millet, sorghum, and groundnuts, gave way to cash crops—peanuts, cotton—whose vulnerability to drought exposed systemic fragility. By the 2000s, international climate assessments flagged West Africa as a hotspot for climate-

induced food insecurity, yet adaptation funding remained minimal and fragmented. Monique's entry into this landscape was shaped by her formative years studying agroecology in Dakar and fieldwork in rural villages, where she witnessed firsthand how climate shocks disproportionately affected women—who bore the burden of water collection, food scarcity, and labor-intensive farming. She rejected top-down “solutions” imposed by foreign NGOs or state agencies, which often ignored local hydrology, crop rotation cycles, or communal land norms. Instead, she adopted a participatory research model, co-developing trials with farmers, using participatory rural appraisal (PRA) techniques to map microclimates, soil types, and water availability. This grounded approach revealed that certain mango varieties—*Mangifera indica* hybrids with deeper root systems and shorter chilling requirements—thrived where conventional cultivars failed. The evolution of the mango rains project unfolded in three phases. Phase one (2013–2016) focused on community mobilization and demonstration plots. Monique established “training circles” where farmers exchanged knowledge on mulching, intercropping with nitrogen-fixing legumes, and water retention pits. While agribusiness giants promote monoculture cash crops optimized for export, her cooperatives cultivate polycultures—mangoes interplanted with moringa, baobab, and medicinal herbs—that enhance biodiversity, soil health, and dietary diversity. This counters the industrial logic of “yield at all costs,” offering a counter-narrative where ecological balance and economic resilience coexist. Yet systemic constraints persist. Land tenure remains insecure: over 70% of Senegal’s agricultural land is held under customary tenure, with formal titles rare. This undermines long-term investment in soil and water infrastructure. Export regulations, governed by the Senegalese Ministry of Agriculture and external bodies like the Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS), impose stringent phytosanitary standards that strain small producers. Monique’s advocacy for reform—particularly the 2022 Land Use and Equity Act—has been a slow burn, facing resistance from land speculators and import-dependent food processors. Globally, the mango rains resonate with broader trends. The United Nations’ Decade on Ecosystem Restoration (2021–2030) and the African Union’s Malabo Declaration on Agricultural Transformation highlight the importance of agroecology and farmer-led innovation. However, funding remains skewed toward large-scale interventions. Only 3% of global climate finance reaches smallholder cooperatives, despite their role in 80% of world food production. Monique’s model—blending grassroots organizing with strategic policy engagement—offers a replicable template, but requires institutional support: credit access, risk insurance, and trade

facilitation tailored to community-scale producers.
