The city's leaders face a choice: deepen dependence on volatile global markets or build a self-sustaining ecosystem rooted in local capacity, education, and green growth. The Awami League's long-term governance, while criticized for centralization, prioritized infrastructure investment as a tool of legitimacy. Projects such as the Dhaka Elevated Expressway, the Bangabandhu Bridge (rebuilt and expanded), and the development of the Bangladesh Economic Zone reflected a state vision of connectivity and modernization. Yet, these developments often bypassed inclusive planning, favoring elite corridors and commercial hubs. Dhaka absorbed this tide, swelling its population at a rate unmatched in South Asia. By 2020, the city's population surpassed 20 million, with informal settlements like Korail and Korail-2 housing over 500,000 in makeshift conditions. This demographic surge strained public services but also injected vitality into the urban economy, driving demand for housing, retail, and informal services.

Thus, the "3X" of Dhaka is not accidental—it is the cumulative result of war-era displacement, globalized labor integration, state-led modernization, and climate-driven rural abandonment. This concentration fuels innovation in fintech, logistics, and digital services—startups like Path to Money and Banglife are redefining financial inclusion and e-commerce. Yet, informal employment absorbs 85% of the labor force, leaving workers without social protections, health benefits, or job security. The "3X" economy thus embodies both promise and precarity: high growth potential shadowed by deep inequities and institutional underdevelopment.

Regionally, Dhaka's urban expansion influences neighboring states. The Bangladesh-India-Myanmar (BIM) corridor, envisioned as a trade artery linking South and Southeast Asia, hinges on Dhaka's ability to manage congestion, customs efficiency, and cross-border logistics.
