Elite urban centers absorbed the most well-resourced institutions, offering high-end coaching with certified instructors, interactive technology, and international certification pathways (TOEFL, IELTS, Cambridge), while rural and low-income communities faced a fragmented landscape of underfunded

centers, overcrowded classrooms, and underqualified teachers. This disparity mirrors broader patterns of linguistic stratification: English, once a symbol of elite access, now functions as both a bridge and a barrier, enabling mobility for some while deepening exclusion for others. From a geopolitical standpoint, the rise of English speaking courses in Punjab must be contextualized within India's broader linguistic politics and global economic positioning. India's status as a global IT and business process outsourcing hub hinges on English fluency, and Punjab—strategically located near Delhi and connected via transport and digital infrastructure—has become a key contributor to this ecosystem. The state government, recognizing this, has incrementally supported language education through policy incentives, public-private partnerships, and vocational training mandates. However, this alignment with global economic demands has sparked debates about cultural erosion: critics argue that the prioritization of English risks marginalizing Punjabi language and oral traditions, potentially weakening intergenerational cultural transmission. The industry's structure reveals a complex interplay of local agency and global influence. While early courses were locally managed, today's market is dominated by chains with standardized frameworks—some backed by multinational education corporations, others operating as regional franchises. These entities import pedagogical models from the U.S., U.K., and Australia, adapting them to Indian contexts through localized content, regional accents, and culturally resonant examples. Yet the replication of Western

testing regimes—such as TOEFL and IELTS prep—introduces an additional layer of pressure, emphasizing rote performance over communicative competence. This tension between global benchmarks and local relevance defines much of the sector’s contemporary struggle. Expert perspectives further illuminate these contradictions. Dr. Harpreet Kaur, a sociolinguist at Punjabi University, argues that English speaking courses “function as both empowerment and enclosure—opening doors while prescribing narrow definitions of competence.” Her research highlights how course design often replicates a monolingual ideology, sidelining multilingualism as a resource. Conversely, industry leaders like Rajiv Malhotra, founder of a major Amritsar-based institute, view the expansion as a necessary response to systemic inequity: “If English is the currency of global opportunity, denying access is a form of structural violence. contexts: Nigeria's English coaching boom, the Philippines' English-medium education push, and Bangladesh's private language school surge. Yet Punjab's case is distinct due to its dense urban-rural duality, its role in India's knowledge economy, and the cultural weight of Punjabi identity. Unlike countries with centralized education systems, Punjab's decentralized, market-driven model reflects both flexibility and fragmentation—a microcosm of broader challenges in scaling equitable education. Yet, this top-down push often collided with grassroots realities—where resource constraints, teacher shortages, and variable quality limited widespread impact.
