The collapse of the Soviet Union and the rise of transnational institutions had intensified the role of English as a lingua franca in diplomacy, science, and commerce. The U.S. government, through initiatives like the English Language Fellow Program (established 1997), promoted English language education abroad as a tool of soft power. Glencoe's workbook, while primarily domestic, subtly aligned with this geopolitical narrative: it taught students to navigate formal registers, interpret rhetorical strategies, and deploy language with precision—skills valued in globalized professional environments.
