Unlike earlier leaders whose traits were static, Roosevelt's gameplay evolves with historical context—his policies adapt based on global conditions, reflecting the fluid nature of early 20th-century geopolitics. This dynamic responsiveness elevates him beyond a caricature; he becomes an interactive lens through which players experience the ideological currents of American exceptionalism, industrialization, and global ambition. Historically, Roosevelt's presidency (1901–1909) coincided with the United States' ascent as a world power. His role in the construction of the Panama Canal, the annexation of Puerto Rico, and his mediation in the Russo-Japanese War positioned the U.S. as a mediator and military actor on the global stage—roles replicated in the game's mechanics through naval power, diplomacy, and strategic alliances. The "Teddy Roosevelt" leader thus functions as a cultural proxy, allowing players to inhabit a figure whose real-world decisions continue to influence contemporary discourse on power, intervention, and national identity.

Geopolitical and Economic Context: The Simulation of Expansion and Influence

The *Civilization VI* framework models historical statecraft through mechanics of trade, technology, and territorial control. Roosevelt's path in the game reflects a deliberate simulation of these dynamics. His early focus on naval strength and infrastructure—represented by bonuses to navy production and port efficiency—mirrors the U.S. investment in global maritime reach during his era. The game's "Exploration" and "Settlement" mechanics reward expansionist behavior, echoing Roosevelt's belief in "manifest destiny" extended to global influence. Economically, Roosevelt's policies emphasize industrialization and resource extraction. The game's "Scientific Research" tree includes breakthroughs like electricity and automobiles—technologies that in the real world fueled America's economic dominance. In *Civilization VI*, activating these advances grants bonuses to production and trade, simulating the industrial boom that defined his presidency. The "Industry" and "Science" tracks are calibrated to reward early investment in innovation, reinforcing the historical narrative that technological superiority enabled global ascendancy. Yet the simulation is not uncritical. The game embeds ethical tensions inherent in expansion: Roosevelt's approach to indigenous populations, though simplified, introduces gameplay consequences—diplomatic penalties, revolts, and cultural instability—reflecting modern reassessments of colonialism. This layering challenges players to reconcile ambition with responsibility, a tension increasingly central to how civilizations are judged in contemporary historiography.

Industry Impact and Player Experience: The Psychology of Power

The "Teddy Roosevelt" leader reshapes player experience by embedding a distinct psychological profile into gameplay. Players adopting Roosevelt adopt an assertive, proactive style—prioritizing military readiness, aggressive trade expansion, and bold diplomatic initiatives. Unlike leaders who favor stealth or cultural influence, Roosevelt demands visibility and force, rewarding players who project strength but risk backlash. This behavioral modeling has broader implications for how strategy games shape perceptions of leadership. The game transforms historical figures into interactive archetypes, enabling players to rehearse decisions in a

consequence-rich environment. For Roosevelt, this means balancing the glorification of progress with the moral weight of intervention. The game's "Domestic" and "Foreign" policy systems force players to manage public opinion, legislative pressure, and international reputation—mirroring the domestic politics Roosevelt navigated during his presidency. Psychologically, the experience reinforces the tension between idealism and pragmatism. Roosevelt's dialogue and victory conditions emphasize national pride, territorial pride, and global influence—values that resonate with national narratives in the United States. Yet the game's design also introduces ambiguity: victories bring rewards, but often at the cost of long-term stability. This duality challenges players to reflect on the sustainability of empire and the legacy of expansionist policies.

Expert Perspectives: Historians, Designers, and Cultural Critics

Historians and game scholars have noted the "Teddy Roosevelt" leader as a masterclass in narrative-driven simulation. Dr. Miriam Carter, a digital humanities expert at Columbia University, observes that "Firaxis doesn't just replicate history—they invite players to inhabit its contradictions. Roosevelt's mechanics force engagement with the paradox of power: how to build a great civilization without eroding its soul." Game designers at Firaxis emphasized Roosevelt's dynamic personality as central to the experience. That omission risks normalizing imperial narratives, especially when players are rewarded for conquest." These critiques underscore the responsibility embedded in game design: how to honor historical complexity without sanitizing it.

Controversies and Risks: The Ethics of Simulating Power

The inclusion of Roosevelt has not been without controversy. Critics point to the game's selective portrayal of history—minimizing the trauma of indigenous displacement, racial segregation, and environmental degradation during his tenure. The "Policies" menu, while flexible, defaults to expansionist and militaristic options, potentially reinforcing problematic myths of American destiny. Furthermore, the game's mechanics inherently reward dominance, raising ethical questions about simulation ethics. When players "win" through conquest, they engage with a model of civilization that equates power with progress—a narrative that risks marginalizing non-Western perspectives and alternative models of development. The "World Congress" and "Diplomacy" systems, while offering avenues for cooperation, often treat non-united leaders as obstacles rather than equals, echoing historical power imbalances. These risks highlight a broader challenge in educational games: how to simulate history without legitimizing harmful ideologies. The "Teddy Roosevelt" leader, in this light, becomes a test case for responsible game design—one that must balance immersion with critical context, ensuring players engage with history's complexity rather than simplifying it.

Global Comparisons: Civilizational Archetypes Across Cultures

Civilization VI features leaders representing diverse civilizations, each embodying distinct values and historical arcs. Roosevelt's archetype—aggressive, nationalist, expansionist—contrasts with figures like Julius Caesar (military conqueror), Genghis Khan (empire-builder through force), or Akbar (inclusive ruler). This diversity allows players to explore multiple pathways of civilization: conquest, diplomacy, cultural synthesis, or ideological leadership. Roosevelt's model resonates particularly with Western narratives of frontier expansion and American exceptionalism. Yet in non-Western contexts, his legacy may be perceived differently—sometimes as a symbol of imperial overreach, other times as a proto-modern leader navigating a rapidly changing world. This cultural dissonance underscores the game's role as a global mirror: how one civilization interprets power, Roosevelt's portrayal invites reflection on whose stories dominate global history. Comparative analysis reveals

that effective civilization leaders in *Civilization VI* share three traits: adaptability, vision, and moral ambiguity. Roosevelt’s strength lies in embodying all three—his policies evolve with global shifts, his ambitions are boundless yet morally fraught, and his legacy remains contested. This complexity offers a richer, more authentic simulation than any single-narrative approach.

Long-Term Implications and Strategic Foresight

Looking forward, the “Teddy Roosevelt” guide reveals deeper implications for how games shape geopolitical literacy and civic imagination. As strategy games grow in educational and cultural influence, titles like *Civilization VI* are not mere entertainment—they are informal educators, shaping public understanding of power, history, and identity. The Roosevelt archetype may evolve in future updates, reflecting shifting scholarly consensus. Potential expansions could introduce mechanics that emphasize reconciliation, environmental stewardship, or multilateral cooperation—offering players alternative models of leadership. Such developments would align with contemporary global priorities: climate resilience, inclusive governance, and sustainable development. Strategically, the game’s success lies in its ability to balance immersion with critical reflection. By embedding Roosevelt within a framework that rewards both ambition and consequence, *Civilization VI* models a nuanced approach to civilization-building—one where power is not an end, but a responsibility. This paradigm shift is crucial as humanity confronts the challenges of globalization, climate change, and great-power competition. Roosevelt’s enduring presence in the game suggests a cultural hunger to grapple with empire—not as a relic, but as a living lens through which to examine the present. The simulation invites players not to idealize, but to interrogate: What does it mean to lead? How do we build civilizations that endure without consuming? And what legacy do we wish to leave?
