This divergence reflects deeper ideological currents: the tension between standardized accountability and creative cognition, a debate increasingly central to global education policy. Controversies surrounding these materials have intensified in recent years. Critics highlight their potential to reinforce fixed mindsets—when children associate “correct” with “color completion,” rather than conceptual understanding—under a growing critique of “measurement culture” in education. Others warn of over-stimulation: the saturation of visual stimuli may impair attention spans, particularly in younger learners. Accessibility remains a persistent issue; while digital versions offer text-to-speech and multilingual support, cost barriers and infrastructure gaps exclude marginalized populations. Moreover, the commercialization of childhood learning has sparked advocacy campaigns for transparency in data use and ethical design standards. From a risk perspective, dependency on digital platforms introduces vulnerabilities: cybersecurity threats, algorithmic opacity, and vendor lock-in.
