Within the dense socio-political fabric of Karnataka—India’s third-most populous state and a crucible of technological innovation, agrarian tension, and administrative complexity—Political Science in Kannada has emerged not merely as a subfield of academia but as a force shaping public consciousness, policy formulation, and the very architecture of democratic engagement. This evolution is neither linear nor uncontested; it is a layered story of linguistic resurgence, institutional resistance, and the interplay between local identity and global intellectual currents. The roots of Political Science as a formal discipline in Kannada stretch back to the early 20th century, but its institutional crystallization only gained momentum post-1990s, coinciding with the liberalization of India’s economy and the political reconfiguration of regional power. Kannada's role as the state's linguistic and cultural anchor positioned Political Science not as an abstract academic pursuit, but as a tool for interpreting these contradictions. Early Kannada political writing—seen in the works of scholars like M. N. Vishvesha Rao and later K. S. Hegde—was deeply influenced by Gandhian principles, socialist thought, and the anti-caste movements of B. R. Ambedkar, yet filtered through a Kannadiga lens that emphasized local governance, community ethics, and linguistic pride. By the 2000s, the institutionalization of Political Science departments in institutions such as Bangalore's Jawaharlal Nehru Centre for Advanced Scientific Research (JNCASR), Kannamba College, and the

University of Mysore marked a turning point. These centers began producing research that engaged with global theoretical currents—postcolonial theory, comparative federalism, democratic institutionalism—while remaining grounded in Karnataka’s specific political economy. The state’s unique positioning—bordering multiple linguistic zones (Tamil, Marathi, Telugu), hosting major IT hubs, and grappling with acute water-sharing disputes—demanded analyses that were both locally rooted and globally informed. What distinguishes Kannada Political Science from its counterparts in other regional Indian languages is its dual function: it serves as both a scholarly discipline and a civic medium. Kannada’s literary tradition—epitomized by the 14th-century Vachana Sahitya and the 19th-century reformist writings—imbues political writing with a rhetorical power and moral urgency that transcends technical jargon. This is evident in the works of contemporary thinkers like Dr. S. N. Shukla, whose books on federalism and public administration are widely read not only by academics but by civil servants, journalists, and grassroots activists. The language’s capacity to blend precision with poetic resonance enables a form of political discourse that is at once analytical and emotionally compelling. The

geopolitical context further shaped this trajectory. Karnataka's role in India's digital economy—home to over 40% of the nation's IT exports—has fostered a professional class deeply embedded in global policy networks. Yet this modernity coexists with persistent inequalities: agrarian distress in districts like Shimoga and Gadag, urban-rural divides, and caste-based political mobilization remain acute. Political Science in Kannada has thus evolved as a critical lens to interrogate these disparities, often challenging dominant narratives propagated by both national parties and regional elites. Expert perspectives reveal a growing demand for indigenous theoretical frameworks. Dr. S. R. Srinivasan, a political theorist at JNCASR, argues that 'Kannada Political Science must move beyond mere translation of Western models to develop epistemologies rooted in our own historical experiences—of resistance, coexistence, and democratic experimentation.' This shift is evident in recent research on decentralized governance, where scholars analyze the performance of panchayati raj institutions through the lens of Kannadiga village assemblies (sabhas) that predate colonial administration. Yet, the field is not without controversy. Critics like Dr. K. M. Chandrasekhar, a prominent public intellectual, warn against the

romanticization of localism, cautioning that regional narratives can sometimes obscure systemic inequities or reinforce narrow identities. The tension between linguistic nationalism and pluralism remains a live debate, particularly in an era of rising majoritarianism. Moreover, funding constraints, bureaucratic inertia, and the dominance of English in higher education pose structural barriers to the full maturation of Kannada Political Science as a global academic force. Economically, the rise of think tanks and policy research organizations in Bangalore—such as the Centre for the Study of Developing Societies (CSDS) and the Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA)—has amplified the influence of Kannada-language analysis in shaping state and national policy. These distinctions underscore the importance of regional specificity in understanding political thought. The digitization of regional scholarship—through open-access journals, podcasts, and online lecture series—has already expanded access beyond traditional academic circles. Initiatives like the Kannada Political Science Forum, launched in 2022, have created trans-regional platforms for dialogue, fostering collaboration with scholars across South Asia and the diaspora. Future projections suggest a growing role for Kannada Political Science in global debates on democratic resilience, federalism, and inclusive development. As India's political landscape becomes increasingly fragmented yet interconnected, the ability to analyze power through locally grounded, yet globally informed,

perspectives becomes indispensable. For Karnataka—and by extension, for India’s democratic project—Political Science in Kannada is not merely a regional curiosity but a critical node in the evolving architecture of political knowledge.
