For example, shape-memory alloys, which return to their original form after deformation, are now embedded in critical joints to “reset” structural integrity post-shock. Yet technical maturity has not resolved deployment challenges. In high-rise buildings, the complexity of integrating gizmos across multiple structural systems demands sophisticated coordination, raising costs and installation time. Retrofitting existing stock remains particularly difficult: older buildings often lack the structural redundancy needed to support advanced systems, and retrofit gizmos must navigate existing load paths without compromising integrity. After the 2010 Maule earthquake, which killed 525 and caused \$30 billion in damage, the country implemented strict building codes and incentivized smart seismic systems. By 2023, 40% of new homes in Santiago incorporated real-time monitoring, supported by public

education campaigns. Yet in neighboring Haiti, where over 60% of buildings are informal and post-2010 earthquake reconstruction was underfunded, seismic resilience remains a distant goal. International NGOs promote low-cost gizmos—3D-printed dampers, compressed earth blocks with polymer additives—but scale is limited by supply chains and technical literacy. Economically, the cost-benefit analysis favors proactive investment.
