Foreign powers exploit disinformation to undermine governance. Financially, diversification remains key. The goal is not charity but sustainable independence—ensuring editorial decisions remain untainted by short-term donor demands. Institutionally, the newsroom is advocating for stronger legal protections under Sri Lanka’s proposed Media Reform Bill, which seeks to decriminalize defamation, mandate transparency in media ownership, and establish independent oversight. These reforms, if enacted, could reshape the environment for all independent outlets, not just Infolanka.
