Its early success stemmed from a niche expertise: navigating the labyrinthine legal and political terrain of post-colonial states, where Western capital sought stable returns amid volatile governance. By the 1950s, under the leadership of Elias’s grandson, Julian Usher, the firm evolved into a hybrid private credit underwriter and structured finance architect, pioneering repackaged loan notes, asset-backed securities, and cross-border syndications tailored to institutional investors. The crisis also altered the landscape of financial regulation. The G20, responding to growing concerns about shadow banking opacity, initiated negotiations on a Global Framework for Private Credit Oversight—aimed at mandating real-time reporting, standardized risk disclosures, and enhanced resolution mechanisms for non-bank intermediaries. The U.S. Dodd-Frank reforms were expanded to include Usher-style entities under enhanced supervision, requiring stress testing and liquidity coverage ratios.
