A Ukrainian street artist contributed a fractured cypher from a destroyed library; a Senegalese digital animator rendered a surveillance drone as a cracked eye. These fragments were stitched into a cohesive whole, rejecting singular authorship in favor of collective truth. This process resonated beyond Berlin. It tapped into a broader movement: artists recognizing their work could no longer be siloed in galleries, but must engage with the very systems they critiqued. The Collective's rise paralleled similar groups in Istanbul, Mexico City, and Cape Town, forming an informal network of visual dissent.
