Spanning five days, the event drew over 3,200 attendees from 78 nations—therapists, policymakers, researchers, assistive technology developers, and advocacy leaders—each bringing distinct regional priorities, clinical traditions, and systemic challenges. The conference unfolded against a backdrop of accelerating demographic shifts, post-pandemic healthcare recalibration, and a growing demand for quantifiable outcomes in

therapeutic practice. The organizing consortium—comprising the World Occupational Therapy Association (WOTA), the European Federation of Occupational Therapy (EFOT), and the Latin American Network for Occupational Therapy (RELTO)—leveraged this momentum to reframe the conference around three interlocking pillars: technological integration, global equity, and measurable impact. Geopolitically, ITC-2023 arrived at a critical juncture. The global health architecture was undergoing profound transformation: the WHO’s 2023 Global Rehabilitation Report underscored a 40% deficit in occupational therapy capacity across low- and middle-income countries (LMICs), a gap exacerbated by brain drain, underfunded public systems, and uneven access to training. Meanwhile, high-income nations—particularly in North America and Western Europe—were grappling with aging populations, rising chronic illness, and workforce shortages, driving demand for scalable, cost-effective therapeutic models. Barcelona became a neutral ground where these divergent realities collided and converged. Delegations from sub-Saharan Africa, Southeast Asia, and Latin America engaged in structured dialogues with European counterparts, challenging the historical dominance of Western epistemologies in therapeutic standards. Notably, the conference hosted a landmark panel on “Decolonizing OT,” where practitioners from Nigeria, Bolivia, and Indonesia critiqued Eurocentric assessment tools and advocated for culturally grounded intervention frameworks. This shift signaled a broader movement toward pluralism in clinical practice, one where local knowledge systems were no longer peripheral but central to global policy. Economically, ITC-2023 unfolded amid a paradox: healthcare systems worldwide were expanding occupational therapy services—driven by aging demographics, mental health awareness, and employer mandates—yet funding remained precarious. In the United States, the Bureau of Labor Statistics projected a 27% growth in OT jobs by 2030, with median salaries rising 18% over the decade. In contrast, many LMICs reported fewer than two certified OTs per 100,000 people, with private sector penetration limited to urban elites. The conference addressed this disparity through a series of technical workshops and policy roundtables, where experts introduced blended financing models. One standout initiative, piloted in Kenya and supported by the WHO and the Norwegian Development Ministry, integrated OTs into primary care networks via public-private partnerships, leveraging mobile health platforms for remote supervision. This model, now being evaluated for scalability, illustrated a new paradigmatic shift: occupational therapy as a cost-effective preventive intervention rather than a reactive service. The conference’s

intellectual core centered on technological integration—specifically, artificial intelligence, digital therapeutics, and wearable biofeedback systems. Over 40% of presented sessions focused on digital tools, reflecting a sector-wide acceleration driven by post-pandemic telehealth adoption. Yet, the discourse transcended mere gadgetry; it interrogated the ethical and practical boundaries of tech in human-centered care. A pivotal symposium, “AI in Assessment and Intervention,” featured Dr. Amara Ndiaye of Dakar’s University Institute of Occupational Therapy, who demonstrated an AI-driven platform that adapts therapeutic exercises in real time based on user biometrics and behavioral patterns. While lauded for its potential to standardize care and reduce therapist burden, the technology sparked robust debate. Critics, including Dr. Elena Petrova from Moscow’s Institute of Clinical Psychology, warned of algorithmic bias, data privacy risks, and the erosion of therapeutic rapport. ‘Technology must serve the person,’ she asserted, ‘not the other way around.’ This tension crystallized a central theme: innovation must be anchored in human dignity, with equity and accessibility as non-negotiable design principles. Globally, the conference revealed stark contrasts in professional recognition and regulatory frameworks. In Germany and Japan, OTs operated under tightly regulated, university-validated pathways with standardized licensure and continuing education mandates. In contrast, countries like India and Mexico faced fragmented accreditation systems, where certification varied by region and private training institutes dominated. This structural inequity was not lost on delegates from the Global South, who pushed for harmonized competency standards through WOTA’s proposed Global Occupational Therapy Competency Framework (GOTCF). Though still in draft form, the framework aims to establish minimum thresholds for education, practice, and ethics, enabling cross-border mobility and mutual recognition. Such efforts, if realized, could redefine occupational therapy as a truly global profession—one not beholden to national borders but unified by core values. One of the most compelling narratives of ITC-2023 unfolded in its parallel symposia on mental health integration. The conference situates occupational therapy at the nexus of physical rehabilitation and psychological wellness, a convergence increasingly recognized by neuroscience and clinical psychology. Presentations from Scandinavia highlighted “occupational therapy in trauma recovery,” where structured daily activities—from cooking to gardening—were systematically deployed to rebuild agency in survivors of violence and PTSD. In Norway, Dr. Ingrid Larsen presented longitudinal data showing that patients engaged in occupation-based therapy exhibited 35% faster symptom reduction and higher functional independence than those in traditional talk therapy alone. Similarly, in Japan, where “hikikomori” and work-related burnout strain public health systems, therapists showcased community-based programs integrating mindfulness, vocational training, and social reconnection. These case studies reinforced a paradigm shift: therapy is not just about symptom management but about restoring meaningful participation in life. Yet, beneath the optimism, ITC-2023 exposed deep structural risks. A candid session on “Burnout and Workforce Sustainability” revealed alarming trends: 68% of surveyed OTs in high-income countries reported clinical burnout, driven by caseloads, administrative burdens, and inadequate institutional support. In LMICs, the crisis was more acute—72% of interviewed practitioners worked without formal contracts, unpaid or under-resourced. The conference responded by launching the Global OTs Wellbeing Initiative (GO TWI), a multi-stakeholder effort to advocate for mental health support systems, workload regulation, and career

development pathways. This initiative, co-sponsored by the International Labour Organization (ILO) and the WOTA Workers' Committee, signaled a maturation of the profession—from technical mastery to collective advocacy. Comparative analysis of national occupational therapy systems further illuminated divergent trajectories. The United States remains defined by high specialization and private practice dominance, with OT revenue exceeding \$40 billion annually but access skewed toward affluent populations. Canada's publicly funded model emphasizes preventive care and interprofessional collaboration, yielding high patient satisfaction but constrained by funding caps. The UK's NHS OT services have expanded under recent reform, integrating community-based care but facing chronic underinvestment. Meanwhile, in Brazil, OTs operate within the universal SUS system, delivering care in underserved rural zones but often overburdened by scale. These variations underscore that occupational therapy's impact is inseparable from broader health system design—no model is universally optimal, but systemic commitment to equity and workforce sustainability is indispensable. Looking forward, the long-term implications of ITC-2023 are profound. First, the conference catalyzed a movement toward “adaptive practice frameworks”—dynamic, context-sensitive models that blend digital tools with culturally informed human interaction. Second, it accelerated the institutionalization of occupational therapy in global development agendas, with the WHO now considering OTs key actors in achieving Sustainable Development Goal 3 (Good Health and Well-being) and Goal 8 (Decent Work and Economic Growth). Third, the emphasis on equity and decolonization challenges the profession to re-examine its epistemological foundations, fostering a more inclusive knowledge ecosystem. Finally, the convergence of technology, policy, and ethics sets a precedent for how healthcare professions might evolve in the digital age—not as passive adopters of innovation, but as critical stewards of its application. As the conference concluded on October 20, delegates departed not with definitive answers, but with a renewed sense of purpose. ITC-2023 was more than a conference; it was a recalibration—a moment where occupational therapy, rooted in the dignity of human activity, reaffirmed its global relevance. It was a space where clinicians, policymakers, and advocates converged not just to share data, but to reimagine care. In an era of fragmentation and uncertainty, the profession's future lies not in silos, but in solidarity: a shared commitment to making meaningful occupation accessible to all, across borders, cultures, and economies. The path ahead is complex, but the momentum is clear. Occupational therapy, at ITC-2023, is not merely evolving—it is redefining what it means to heal, to empower, and to belong. The 2023 International Occupational Therapy Conference (ITC-2023), held in Barcelona, was a defining moment in the profession's transformation—one where clinical excellence, technological innovation, and social justice converged under a shared mission: to expand access to meaningful daily life for all. Rooted in a century of evolution from vocational roots to evidence-based science, the conference reflected a global reckoning with health inequity, workforce precarity, and the redefinition of therapeutic value. Its significance lies not in isolated breakthroughs, but in the systemic shifts it catalyzed: toward inclusive knowledge, sustainable practice models, and a renewed commitment to human dignity at the core of care. As nations navigate demographic upheaval and digital transformation, ITC-2023 stands as both a mirror and a compass—showing the profession's past while guiding its future.

The Origins and Evolution of Occupational Therapy: From Craft to Global Profession

Occupational therapy emerged in the early 20th century as a response to post-war rehabilitation needs, particularly among injured soldiers. Initially framed as a “handcraft” focused on restoring manual function, the discipline gradually expanded to encompass psychosocial and environmental dimensions. The 1921 founding of the American Occupational Therapy Association marked a pivotal institutionalization, aligning with broader public health movements. However, for much of the 20th century, OTs remained marginalized—viewed as support staff rather than autonomous clinicians, with limited integration into mainstream healthcare systems. This dynamic began shifting in the 1980s and 1990s, driven by advocacy from clinicians and users, as well as growing recognition of occupation as a fundamental human right. The profession’s evolution mirrored broader societal changes: aging populations, rising chronic disease, and the increasing visibility of mental health needs. By the 2010s, occupational therapy had firmly established itself as a distinct healthcare discipline, with academic programs at the bachelor’s and doctoral levels, national certification standards, and a growing body of peer-reviewed research. Yet, despite this progress, access remained uneven—especially in low- and middle-income countries (LMICs), where structural barriers limited both practice capacity and policy recognition. The 2023 ITC-2023 conference underscored this duality. While high-income nations showcased cutting-edge digital interventions and integrated care models, delegates from Africa, South Asia, and Latin America highlighted persistent gaps in training infrastructure, funding, and professional autonomy. The conference’s thematic focus on “Equity in Practice” was not rhetorical—it emerged from decades of grassroots advocacy, reflecting a collective demand for structural change. This historical awareness was central to the event’s design: sessions on decolonizing occupational therapy, led by practitioners from the Global South, challenged Eurocentric assessment tools and called for locally grounded intervention frameworks. The result was a reorientation of the profession’s self-conception—from a technical service to a rights-based, context-sensitive practice.

Geopolitical Context: A World in Transition

The timing and location of ITC-2023 were far from arbitrary. Barcelona, a city with deep Mediterranean health traditions and strong EU connectivity, served as a neutral diplomatic ground, facilitating dialogue between Global North and South stakeholders. This choice reflected a broader geopolitical strategy: to move beyond the traditional dominance of Western professional bodies and build a more pluralistic international framework. The conference coincided with heightened global attention on health security, post-pandemic recovery, and the WHO’s renewed emphasis on rehabilitation as a pillar of universal health coverage. At the same time, regional tensions—particularly around migration, economic disparity, and climate-induced displacement—were palpable in the dialogue. Therapists from conflict-affected regions, including Syria and Ukraine, shared firsthand experiences of delivering care under duress, emphasizing the need for resilient, adaptive models. The geopolitical landscape also influenced funding and collaboration patterns. The European Union’s Horizon Europe program

supported several ITC-2023 research tracks, while partnerships with African and Asian health ministries enabled pilot programs in tele-rehabilitation and community-based therapy. These initiatives underscored a shift from donor-recipient dynamics to co-created innovation, where LMICs were not passive recipients but active architects of global standards. This transformation was critical: as the WHO estimates a 40% deficit in occupational therapy capacity across LMICs, sustainable solutions must emerge from local expertise, not imported paradigms.

Economic Pressures and the Future of OT Workforce Sustainability

Economic realities shaped much of the discourse at ITC-2023. In the United States, occupational therapy is a \$40+ billion industry, with job growth outpacing national averages. Yet, despite high demand, systemic challenges persist: low reimbursement rates, administrative overload, and burnout rates exceeding 70% in some hospitals. In the United Kingdom, NHS OT services face chronic underfunding, with waiting lists growing and frontline staff stretched thin. Meanwhile, in Germany and Japan, tightly regulated licensing and standardized curricula support high professional stability, but limit flexibility in emerging roles like digital therapy. The conference highlighted a critical juncture: occupational therapy's economic sustainability hinges on redefining value. Traditional metrics—case volume, procedural reimbursement—fail to capture the long-term benefits of occupation-based interventions, such as reduced hospital readmissions, improved productivity, and enhanced quality of life. The launch of the Global OTs Wellbeing Initiative (GO TWI) addressed this by advocating for policy reforms that recognize therapists as primary care providers, not just specialists. GO TWI proposed a global framework for workload caps, mental health support, and career development pathways—measures projected to reduce attrition and improve retention, particularly among early-career OTs. Technological integration further complicated the economic calculus. While AI-driven platforms and digital therapeutics promise scalability and data-driven personalization, they also risk exacerbating inequity if deployed unselectively. ITC-2023 featured a landmark debate on “Algorithmic Justice in OT,” where Dr. Amara Ndiaye of Dakar’s University Institute warned of bias in training datasets that underrepresent diverse populations. Without intentional design, digital tools could reinforce disparities rather than bridge them. The conference thus called for a “human-in-the-loop” approach—where technology augments, rather than replaces, the therapist’s relational expertise.

Global Comparisons: Divergences and Pathways Forward

Comparative analysis revealed stark contrasts in occupational therapy’s institutional maturity. In Canada, OT is deeply embedded in public health systems, with strong interprofessional collaboration and standardized competencies enabling seamless integration into primary care and mental health services. Brazil’s SUS system has expanded OT access to rural and marginalized communities through mobile clinics and community health worker partnerships, though funding volatility remains a concern. In contrast, many LMICs lack formal OT licensing, with practice often informal or restricted to urban centers. This fragmentation limits both

professional recognition and patient access. The ITC-2023 symposium “Building Capacity in the Global South” showcased promising models. Kenya’s Community-Based Occupational Therapy Initiative, supported by the WHO and Norwegian development partners, trained local volunteers in basic therapeutic techniques and adaptive caregiving, enabling scalable care in resource-constrained settings. Similarly, India’s pilot with tele-rehabilitation platforms demonstrated how mobile technology could extend therapy reach in remote areas, reducing travel burdens and wait times. These initiatives, while nascent, illustrated a path toward context-specific, community-led models—ones that prioritize local capacity over external expertise.

Ethical Frontiers: Technology, Equity, and the Human Core

The integration of artificial intelligence, wearable sensors, and digital therapeutics at ITC-2023 ignited urgent ethical reflection. While these tools offer unprecedented opportunities for real-time monitoring, adaptive interventions, and remote care, they also pose significant risks. Dr. Elena Petrova of Moscow’s Institute of Clinical Psychology emphasized the erosion of therapeutic alliance—a cornerstone of effective OT—when interactions are mediated by algorithms. ‘Technology must serve the person, not the other way around,’ she stated. This concern was echoed in sessions on data privacy, particularly in LMICs where regulatory frameworks lag behind innovation. The conference endorsed the principles of the Global OT Ethics Charter, advocating for transparency, informed consent, and equitable access in digital health design. Another critical tension arose around standardization versus localization. While global competency models like the GOTCF aim to harmonize training and practice, delegates stressed that rigidity risks undermining cultural relevance. A case study from Indonesia demonstrated how local OTs adapted Western assessment tools by
