Japanese math textbooks, for instance, embed fractions in story-based problems involving shared meals, construction, and trade, reinforcing cultural values of collective responsibility and practical application. These nations consistently outperform the U.S. in PISA math assessments, where problem-solving depth is paramount. In contrast, many low-income countries face systemic barriers: teacher training gaps, outdated worksheets, and linguistic fragmentation hinder consistent fraction instruction. Yet even in progressive contexts, equity concerns persist—students in underfunded U.S. districts often receive worksheets with culturally irrelevant scenarios (e.g., “If a store sells $\frac{5}{8}$ of a liter of juice,”) which fail to resonate, further entrenching achievement gaps. The economic context underpinning these practices cannot be overstated. As knowledge economies demand fluency in quantitative reasoning, early math education has become a proxy for future workforce readiness. Repeated exposure to abstract, high-pressure word problems correlates with elevated math anxiety, particularly in students already vulnerable to stereotype threat. A 2022 meta-analysis in *Educational Psychology Review* found that students from underrepresented groups show significantly lower performance in fraction tasks when worksheets lack contextual relevance or when feedback is delayed—indicating systemic inequities in both curriculum design and classroom dynamics. Globally, comparative studies reveal divergent trajectories. In Finland, where education prioritizes formative assessment over standardized testing, fraction instruction emphasizes exploration and peer dialogue—students use stories, games, and real-world projects to build intuition. This approach correlates with high student agency and low anxiety, though it demands substantial teacher training and autonomy. In contrast, Singapore’s “model method”—a visual, step-by-step narrative technique—dominates global attention for its efficacy but requires precise teacher calibration to avoid rote mimicry. Meanwhile, in Nigeria, where 5th grade

classrooms often lack basic materials, fraction problems are frequently solved orally through local market exchanges, blending informal numeracy with cultural practice—a model of contextual authenticity often overlooked by global policy.
