What began as informal peer-generated content rapidly coalesced into structured, widely accessed study guides, forming what scholars now describe as a “study ecosystem” embedded in social learning networks. These contrasting models highlight a fundamental ideological rift: whether knowledge should be standardized and gamified, or contextualized and critically engaged.
