Atwood herself has acknowledged this tension, emphasizing that while Gilead’s form is fictional, its roots are deeply rooted in specific historical and theological traditions—yet its implications are universal. The challenge, as scholars like Dr. Leila Ahmed, a leading expert on Islamic feminism, point out, is to read the text as both a warning and a challenge: to recognize one’s own cultural blind spots while refusing complacency. The economic dimensions of the *Handmaid’s Tale’s* success are equally telling. The ebook’s scalability enabled micro-targeted distribution: campaigns in Nigeria sent digital copies to women’s rights groups; universities in Eastern Europe integrated it into political science curricula; underground networks in repressive states used encrypted channels to share the text.
