Geometry, both Euclidean and coordinate, is emphasized not merely for theoretical correctness but for spatial reasoning, a skill increasingly vital in fields like architecture, robotics, and computer graphics. Data interpretation, presented through graphs, pie charts, and

tables, aligns with India's digital economy, where data literacy is no longer optional but essential. Notably, the sample paper increasingly incorporates "application-based" questions—problems rooted in everyday contexts, such as calculating interest rates, optimizing resources, or analyzing statistical trends. This shift signals a departure from abstract exercises toward practical numeracy, aiming to produce graduates who can apply mathematics beyond the classroom.
