The earliest surviving physical examples—such as the **Carta Marinara della Costa Africana** (c. 1375), housed in the Biblioteca Marciana—reveal a synthesis of Mediterranean and Atlantic knowledge. Its borders are lined with geometric compasses and compass roses, yet its inner sections burst with intricate illustrations: coral reefs rendered in ochre and lapis, fishing villages painted in delicate blues and greens, and mythological figures mediating between sea and sky. This fusion of science and symbolism was not decorative excess—it was cognitive architecture, designed to encode complex navigational logic in a form accessible to trained eyes. The geopolitical climate of the time shaped both content and dissemination. The 1343 Battle of La Rochelle, in which Genoese vessels clashed with French forces, underscored the vulnerability of uncoordinated navigation. Similarly, Portuguese expeditions down the West African coast, led by Prince Henry the Navigator’s nascent school at Sagres, demanded faster, more reliable charts. The *Arte Marinaresca* responded by integrating astronomical data—lunar

positions, solar altitudes—into its illustrations, enabling sailors to recalibrate their courses without relying solely on coastal landmarks. Yet access to this knowledge was tightly controlled. In the Maluku Islands, for instance, indigenous navigators maintained oral traditions enriched by symbolic maps etched on bark and woven mats, echoing the metaphorical cartography of the *Arte Marinaresca*. These hybrid systems, blending ancestral knowledge with colonial maps, became sites of cultural resistance and adaptation. Economically, the *Arte Marinaresca* underpinned the early globalization of trade. Spice fleets, silver convoys, and slave routes relied on its detailed coastal profiles and hazard warnings. A single illustration of a reef’s depth, rendered in precise hachure, could determine the survival of a galleon and the profitability of a voyage.
