The first victim, 28-year-old Eleanor Whitmore, a schoolteacher and community organizer, vanished on a storm-littered night in January 1978. Two months later, James Holloway, a former Mine Safety Inspector turned whistleblower, turned up dead in his home—shot once through the window. The second victim, Dr. Marcus Langston, a geologist hired to assess seismic risks in the area, disappeared just days after publishing a classified report warning of subsurface instability linked to illegal blasting. The pattern was chilling: each victim had probed or spoken out on issues tied to land use, environmental degradation, or corporate negligence. The connections were not immediately obvious, but a deeper investigation revealed a network of silences—official records redacted, local officials beholden to regional elites, and federal agencies with conflicting mandates.
