Mildred Loving, then 73, was a woman shaped by decades of systemic marginalization, legal erasure, and psychological resilience. Born in 1935 in rural Virginia, she grew up under Jim Crow’s suffocating regime, where legal segregation dictated not only public life but private personhood. Her family, like thousands of Black families across the South, lived in the shadow of *Plessy v. Ferguson*, their existence governed by statutes that denied basic dignity. But Mildred’s story diverged from the silence imposed by such systems. In 1958, she became entangled in a legal battle that would reach the U.S. Supreme Court—not as a defendant, but as the central figure in *Loving v.
