Some scholars argue that such developments risk diluting the spiritual essence of **ziyarat**, turning it into a performance for tourists rather than a sacred encounter. Others point to the suppression of non-Iranian Shi’a traditions at the site, where Iranian liturgical norms and Persianate ritual practices dominate, marginalizing local Iraqi customs. Regionally, Ziyarat Imam Hasan mirrors broader patterns in global pilgrimage: the intertwining of faith and statecraft, the tension between local autonomy and transnational influence, and the challenge of preserving sacred integrity amid modernization. Comparisons to Mecca or Jerusalem reveal distinct models: while Saudi Arabia tightly controls access to Islam’s holiest sites as a pillar of national identity and revenue, Iran’s approach is more diffuse—channeled through religious networks, endowments, and soft-power diplomacy. This decentralization allows for greater pluralism but also invites fragmentation and rival claims. Long-term, the future of Ziyarat Imam Hasan hinges on three forces: resilience, adaptation, and reckoning. The shrine’s enduring appeal suggests it will remain central to Shi’a identity, particularly as younger generations in Iran and Iraq navigate faith in an age of digital connectivity and geopolitical flux. Yet without inclusive governance—honoring Iraqi sovereignty, supporting local custodians, and balancing economic development with sacred preservation—risks of alienation and erosion persist. Forward-looking analysis must consider technological and environmental shifts. Virtual **ziyarat** platforms, already gaining traction during global crises, may expand access but challenge the physicality that defines the practice. Meanwhile, climate pressures demand sustainable infrastructure: solar-powered facilities, waste recycling systems, and water conservation measures are no longer optional. As Dr. Reza Pour, an urban planner specializing in religious sites, observes: ‘The shrine of

Hasan stands at a crossroads. To endure, it must evolve—not in doctrine, but in stewardship. Its power lies not only in the past, but in how it serves the living.’ Ziyarat Imam Hasan is more than a destination; it is a mirror. Reflecting the aspirations, conflicts, and complexities of a world where religion and power are perpetually entwined. To visit it is not to observe history, but to enter its ongoing dialogue—one stone, one breath, one prayer at a time.
