The study, therefore, was not just about ratings—it was a diagnostic tool for survival. The success of **Encanto**’s hybrid rollout and the **Star Wars: The Acolyte** serialized streaming model demonstrated a recalibration toward narrative

pacing and audience retention. Internally, the company restructured its content teams into “platform pods,” cross-functional units that integrated production, marketing, and data analytics to optimize timing, format, and audience targeting. Economically, the study exposed a stark dichotomy. While Disney+ subscriptions grew to 160 million globally by late 2024, average revenue per user (ARPU) remained under pressure in mature markets due to saturation and aggressive discounting. In contrast, emerging markets saw higher engagement but lower monetization, often due to payment friction and lower willingness to pay. As Western studios grapple with market saturation and regulatory pushback, state-backed media powers—China’s Tencent, India’s Disney+ Hotstar, South Korea’s CJ ENM—are leveraging national narratives and platform control to expand influence. The U.S. media industry’s ability to maintain soft power will depend on its capacity

to innovate beyond IP franchises and embrace inclusive, culturally resonant storytelling. Economically, the shift toward direct audience relationships—bypassing traditional intermediaries—redefines value chains. Subscription models, once seen as secondary, now anchor global revenue, but they demand sustained investment in content depth and user experience. The study's data shows that retention hinges not just on quantity, but on quality of engagement: binge-watching of Disney+ peaked not with a single release, but with consistent, meaningful content flows that foster emotional investment. Culturally, the study reflects a generational reckoning. Younger audiences reject passive consumption; they demand participation, representation, and authenticity. Disney's struggles to diversify its on-screen talent and storytelling—despite public pressure—highlight the tension between legacy brand image and evolving social expectations. In emerging markets, the narrative diverged sharply. India, with over 800 million internet users, emerged as a growth frontier. Disney+ Hotstar—bolstered by localized content, including regional language series and cricket streaming—became the country’s leading streaming

platform, surpassing Netflix in monthly active users by Q3 2024. This success stemmed not just from Disney's brand, but from strategic alignment with India's digital ecosystem: affordable mobile data plans, partnerships with telecom providers, and hyper-localized marketing that emphasized family-centric storytelling. The study noted that Disney's ability to adapt—by producing content in Hindi, Tamil, and Telugu—was pivotal, contrasting with earlier attempts to export Western-centric narratives that underperformed. Southeast Asia presented a different challenge. In Indonesia and Vietnam, where internet penetration varied widely and mobile-first platforms like TikTok and ShopeeTV dominated, Disney's linear channels struggled to retain youth audiences. The study highlighted a critical insight: in markets with high platform fragmentation, Disney's future depended not on broad reach, but on strategic exclusivity—delivering premium content through owned platforms rather than competing on open-access aggregation. This shift aligned with Disney's broader "platform-first" strategy, where intellectual property (IP) was leveraged across multiple owned experiences: theme park integrations, interactive games, and AR filters. Europe introduced a regulatory dimension absent in U.S. markets. The European Union's Digital Services Act (DSA) and Audiovisual Media Services Directive (AVMSD) imposed strict requirements on content transparency, diversity quotas, and algorithmic accountability. The study found that Disney's compliance with these mandates—particularly its investment in regional content production and adherence to local advertising standards—gave it a competitive edge over less-responsive platforms. Yet it also underscored a growing tension: as regulators demanded greater cultural protectionism, Disney's global IP strategy faced friction with local content mandates, forcing a recalibration toward co-productions and regional studios. China, though excluded from direct Disney+ operations, loomed large in the study's comparative analysis. The dominance of domestic platforms like Tencent Video and iQIYI—backed by state-supported content policies and hyper-localized user experiences—illustrated the limits of Western IP in markets with strong cultural sovereignty. Disney's licensing agreements with Chinese partners, particularly for *Mickey Mouse*-branded merchandise and co-produced animated films, revealed a pragmatic adaptation: rather than direct streaming, the company focused on experiential branding through theme park zones and localized digital content hubs. In Latin America, the study noted a dual reality. Brazil and Mexico saw robust growth in Disney+ subscriptions, driven by youth demand and expanding mobile data access. Yet in Argentina and Venezuela, economic instability and currency controls undermined subscription viability, pushing Disney to prioritize transactional models—pay-per-view, ad-supported tiers, and bundled telecom offers. This regional segmentation highlighted a broader truth: global media strategies must be as adaptive as the economies they serve. The study also illuminated the economic interdependence between Disney and its ecosystem partners. In India, for instance, Disney+ Hotstar's success relied on collaborations with telecom giants like Jio, offering zero-rated data access to subscribers. In Southeast Asia, partnerships with Grab and Shopee enabled cross-promotional campaigns, embedding Disney content into daily digital routines. These alliances, the research showed, were not peripheral—they were central to Disney's ability to scale in markets where platform ecosystems dictate consumer behavior. Crucially, the study framed these regional dynamics within a global economic framework marked by rising protectionism, digital taxation, and currency volatility. The U.S. Federal Trade Commission's antitrust scrutiny of major tech mergers, coupled with EU digital levies, signaled a new era of regulatory friction that would impact Disney's M&A strategies and platform expansion.
