This threshold, long thought unattainable for non-utility-scale wind, unlocked unprecedented private investment. Multinational energy firms, recognizing that future grids would demand distributed resilience, began integrating Dune clusters into hybrid microgrids, pairing them with solar farms and battery storage. The technology’s modularity allowed incremental scaling, reducing financial exposure in volatile markets. Yet the road was not without tectonic friction. Traditional energy powers, from OPEC states to established utilities, viewed Dune not as a partner but as a disruptor. In 2024, Saudi Aramco and Russia’s Gazprom jointly launched a counter-initiative: the Desert Shield Program, focused on hardening centralized fossil infrastructure against
