This dual heritage positioned Diana at a liminal crossroads—neither fully European nor American, neither wholly insider nor outsider, but a cosmopolitan subject shaped by geopolitical flux. Her upbringing in Geneva, where the family maintained a discreet but influential presence amid diplomatic missions and global finance, instilled an early awareness of power’s invisible architecture. Yet, it was her teenage years,

spent navigating elite boarding schools and private exchanges in Switzerland, France, and the UK, that crystallized her understanding of love not as pure emotion but as a site of negotiation—between legacy and autonomy, visibility and concealment.
