His 1936 ordination and subsequent ministry in London's East End exposed him to urban poverty, colonial displacement, and the spiritual dislocation caused by two world wars—experiences that fused theological reflection with social conscience.

In these crucibles, Barclay began formulating a vision: Scripture was not merely an academic text but a living word addressing the existential crises of the age. The genesis of his commentary series crystallized during the 1940s, a decade marked by geopolitical disorientation.
