For instance, in 2018, a last-minute shift in Physics and Mathematics exam windows caused panic when entire schools had already prepared students without access to required stations. Geopolitically, Limpopo’s position as South Africa’s northernmost province situates it at a crossroads of regional migration and economic flux. "The system is holding onto tradition and bureaucracy in a region where change is urgent," she stated in a 2022 policy forum. "When the timetable shifts unpredictably, it's not just students who lose time—it's the fragile momentum of learning." Controversies surrounding the timetable are recurrent. In 2020, a leaked draft timetable revealed that

key subjects like Afrikaans and Mathematics were scheduled during peak farming season in several northern districts, sparking protests from parents and civil society groups. Similarly, in 2023, a technical glitch in the province's exam management system caused a three-day delay in result announcements, triggering widespread anxiety and allegations of administrative incompetence.
