In Asia, the reception is mixed. In China and India, where state influence over capital allocation is pronounced, his framework is adapted cautiously—used to assess private firms while acknowledging the primacy of policy over pure market signals. Emerging markets offer a more nuanced picture. In Latin America, where currency volatility and sovereign risk are endemic, Damodaran's Country Risk Premiums (CRPs) are widely adopted but often seen as overly conservative. In Africa, where data scarcity limits DCF precision, his qualitative adjustments gain traction—though local investors caution against importing a model developed with rich-market assumptions. This global divergence underscores a key insight: no valuation system is culturally neutral.
