In the U.S., companies like Khan Academy and Prestige Prep report record enrollments for June-level course bundles, while in China, “cram schools” (补习班) dominate after-school hours, their curricula tightly synchronized with the national Gaokao's high school phases—including grade 11 content. This commercialization raises ethical questions. Critics argue that the profit motive risks distorting pedagogy, prioritizing test-taking strategies over genuine learning.
