It drew from the Leo zodiac’s traditional associations: leadership, courage, and charisma, adapting these mythic qualities into a consumer identity. This was not merely marketing; it was a sociocultural signal, designed to resonate with a generation of women navigating post-2008 economic precarity, gendered workplace dynamics, and the rising visibility of female entrepreneurialism. Yet beneath the veneer of empowerment lay structural tensions—tensions that would become visible as “red flags” emerging in public discourse.

Geopolitical and Economic Foundations: The Rise of the Femme Economy

The ascendance of the “Leo Woman” brand must be understood within the broader geopolitical and economic transformation of the 21st century.
