Expert analysis reveals FFGTs as both a symptom and a catalyst of institutional transformation. Dr. Amina Ndiaye, a Senegalese conflict scholar at the University of Dakar, observes: ‘FFGTs are not merely tools—they are epistemic interventions. They challenge the monopoly of expert knowledge by embedding local agency into the very architecture of dialogue.’ This democratization enhances legitimacy but also introduces complexity. Facilitation, once the domain of trained specialists, now involves community elders, youth leaders, and displaced populations—all guided by a shared template. Donor funding, academic research, and standard-setting bodies—largely based in Europe, North America, and East Asia—shape the template’s evolution.
