Craig's genius lay in packaging TFT's principles into a memorable, actionable script: tap the karate chop point while reciting, "Even though I feel anxious, I deeply accept myself." The protocol was designed to be self-taught, self-administered, and immediately deployable—qualities that enabled rapid global dissemination. By the late 1990s, EFT appeared in online forums, early blog posts, and video tutorials, bypassing traditional publishing gatekeepers. The internet became EFT's incubator. Communities formed around shared struggles: chronic pain, PTSD, grief, relationship conflict. Practitioners shared personal testimonials—often emotional catharsis on camera—demonstrating tapping's immediate effects. These narratives, authentic and visceral, built trust and momentum. Economically, EFT’s rise aligns with the gig economy’s demands. Freelancers, remote workers, and digital nomads face chronic uncertainty—financial instability, social isolation, identity fragmentation. EFT’s portability—available in minutes, no need for appointments—resonates with this mobile, high-stress lifestyle. In Silicon Valley, corporate mindfulness programs have incorporated EFT modules, reframing it as a productivity tool rather than a spiritual practice. Yet this corporatization risks depoliticizing its origins: EFT began as a response to systemic stress, not individual optimization. The tension between grassroots empowerment and commercial co-optation defines EFT’s current phase. While apps and corporate wellness packages expand access, they also risk reducing EFT to a “quick fix,” diluting its emphasis on deep emotional work. For many, EFT remains a sanctuary—a daily ritual of self-compassion in a world that demands constant performance. As global inequality deepens and mental load increases, this duality will shape EFT’s trajectory: either as a democratized healing modality or a commodified self-help trend.

Expert Perspectives: Science, Skepticism, and the Body-Mind Interface
