Historical and cultural narratives—especially those involving marginalized communities—often resist linear progression, privileging cyclical, relational, or episodic time structures. In Indigenous pedagogies, for instance, storytelling sequences may emphasize interconnectedness over chronological order, challenging Western linear models embedded in most worksheets. This tension reflects a broader debate: whether sequence worksheets should reinforce dominant epistemologies or evolve to reflect pluralistic ways of knowing. Moreover, equity concerns persist. While digital tools promise personalization, access remains uneven. These differences underscore how national values—whether equity, innovation, or rigor—shape pedagogical tools.
