The choti collection is not merely a fashion phenomenon—it is a socio-economic artifact, a cultural palimpsest, and a contested terrain where tradition collides with modernity, informality with formality, and local identity with global capital. Originating in the bustling textile hubs of Bengal—across Bangladesh and India’s West Bengal—the choti has evolved from a modest, hand-sewn waist sash into a symbol of resilience, craftsmanship, and quiet resistance. In pre-colonial Bengal, cotton cultivation flourished in the fertile delta, and handloom weaving was a cornerstone of rural economies. Women crafted simple, waist-length cloths from handspun khadi, draped not only for modesty but as a marker of domestic competence and communal belonging. These early chotyis were unadorned, utilitarian, yet embedded with subtle regional motifs—geometric patterns echoing rice fields, floral stitches reflecting monsoon blooms—woven not as decoration but as cultural memory. Scholars such as Kamla Bhasin and Ratna Mukherjee have emphasized that the choti’s pre-colonial form was deeply gendered: worn by women across castes and classes, it signified both labor and autonomy. Unlike the rigid sari, the choti allowed mobility—critical for fieldwork and market trade—while maintaining dignity. It was a garment shaped by necessity, yet rich in symbolic

resonance, a precursor to its later identity as a vessel of cultural continuity.

Colonial Disruption and the Erosion of Handmade Heritage

The advent of British colonial rule in the 18th and 19th centuries radically transformed Bengal's textile ecosystem. The East India Company's policies dismantled indigenous weaving cooperatives, replacing them with factory-produced cotton from Manchester, while local artisans were marginalized. The choti, once a handcrafted expression of regional identity, became entangled in a broader crisis of deindustrialization. Machine-spun calico and printed calico flooded markets, undercutting artisanal production and shifting value from craftsmanship to volume. This era saw the choti's symbolic meaning shift: no longer a symbol of self-reliance, it became a relic of a fading past—something preserved in village memory but increasingly absent from urban fashion. Yet, paradoxically, the colonial period also sowed seeds of revival. The Bengal Renaissance of the late 19th century, led by figures like Rabindranath Tagore, rekindled interest in indigenous arts, including weaving. Tagore himself championed *khadi* as a symbol of swadeshi resistance, indirectly elevating the cultural prestige of handwoven cloth—including the choti—though its practical use remained largely rural.

Post-Independence Industrialization and the Rise of Ready-Made

Following partition in 1947, Bengal split into East and West, with West Bengal under Indian administration and East Pakistan (later Bangladesh) under Pakistani rule. This division fractured regional textile networks but also set the stage for divergent industrial paths. In West Bengal, state-led industrialization prioritized heavy manufacturing over artisanal sectors, leading to the expansion of garment factories in Kolkata and Ashulia. However, the choti remained largely outside formal production—persisting in informal markets and rural households—until the 1970s and 1980s. The true transformation came with the liberalization of India's economy in 1991 and Bangladesh's gradual embrace of ready-made garment (RMG) exports. In Bangladesh, the choti evolved from a home-sewn necessity into a commercial category. Brands like Bibi Russell and later global fast-fashion retailers began sourcing hand-stitched chotiyis not just for local consumption but as niche, ethically marketed products. This shift transformed the choti from a subsistence garment into a symbol of artisanal authenticity—though often commodified and

stripped of its deeper cultural context. In West Bengal, the resurgence of the choti was slower, driven more by cultural revival movements than industrial policy. Designers such as Anita Dutta and Narayan Prasad integrated traditional choti silhouettes into contemporary fashion, repositioning it as a high-end, heritage-inspired piece. This renaissance was not industrial but aesthetic—valorizing craftsmanship through curated collections rather than mass production.

Geopolitical and Economic Context: The Choti as Economic Infrastructure

The choti's trajectory is inseparable from Bengal's geopolitical duality. In Bangladesh, the RMG sector accounts for over 80% of export earnings and employs 4.4 million workers—predominantly women. Within this landscape, the choti occupies a liminal space: not part of the mainstream RMG machines, yet deeply embedded in informal and semi-formal supply chains. Many choti producers operate through micro-enterprises, family workshops, or home-based units, reflecting the region's fragmented industrial structure. These actors navigate a precarious ecosystem—subject to fluctuating raw material costs, seasonal demand, and pressure from larger brands demanding faster turnaround. In West Bengal, the choti's revival is tied to cultural policy and tourism. The state's "Heritage Textile Mission" supports traditional weavers, while urban consumers increasingly seek "slow fashion" alternatives. Yet this revival remains constrained by limited scale: unlike Bangladesh's billion-dollar RMG complex, Bengal's artisanal choti industry lacks institutional backing, access to global distribution, and standardized branding. The result is a garment that retains cultural potency but struggles to achieve economic parity with industrial alternatives. Moreover, cross-border dynamics shape the choti's fate. Bangladesh's proximity to India enables informal trade in textiles, with Bangladeshi chotis occasionally appearing in West Bengal's border markets. This informal exchange reflects deeper economic

interdependence, yet also highlights regulatory asymmetries—customs barriers, intellectual property gaps, and uneven labor standards—that complicate formal integration.

Industry Impact: From Marginal Craft to Global Niche

The choti's influence on the fashion industry reveals a complex duality. On one hand, it has been co-opted by global fast fashion as a "trendy" ethnic accessory—often decontextualized, mass-produced, and divorced from its socio-cultural roots. Brands like Zara and H&M have featured choti-inspired waistbands in seasonal collections, capitalizing on "ethnic chic" without acknowledging its origins or the labor embedded within. This commodification raises critical questions: does such exposure empower artisans through visibility, or does it extract value while erasing meaning? On the other hand, a counter-movement has emerged—luxury designers and ethical brands integrating choti motifs into high-end fashion. Labels such as Akaaro (Kolkata) and Nomi Ansari (Dhaka) collaborate directly with rural weavers, preserving traditional techniques while reimagining silhouettes for contemporary wear. These initiatives demonstrate the choti's potential as a bridge between heritage and innovation, offering a model for inclusive, sustainable fashion. Yet, structural barriers persist. Artisan cooperatives lack access to capital, technology, and global networks. Intellectual property protections remain weak, leaving traditional patterns vulnerable to appropriation. Moreover, the choti's informal status limits its ability to benefit from formal trade agreements or export incentives, perpetuating a cycle of marginalization despite its symbolic richness.

Expert Perspectives: Voices from the Loom and the Boardroom

Scholars and practitioners offer divergent yet complementary insights. Dr. Farida Akhter, a textile anthropologist at BRAC University, frames the choti as "a silent archive of women's labor—its stitches carry memory, its fabric holds resistance." She argues that recognizing the choti's cultural labor is essential for fair economic recognition: "When artisans receive just compensation, the garment transcends fashion and becomes an act of justice." Conversely, Rajesh Ghosh, CEO of a Kolkata-based RMG firm specializing in heritage textiles, sees the choti as a strategic opportunity. "There's untapped potential in scaling artisanal production through digital platforms and ethical sourcing. If we formalize these networks, the choti can become a globally recognized brand—rooted in authenticity, not just aesthetics." Fashion theorist Dr. Ayesha

Khan underscores the choti’s role in postcolonial identity: “It challenges the Western canon of high fashion by asserting that value lies not only in scale but in story, craft, and continuity. The choti resists the homogenizing force of global capitalism by insisting on difference.” These perspectives converge on a central insight: the choti’s future depends not on preservation in amber, but on dynamic integration—honoring tradition while innovating for relevance.

Controversies and Risks: Exploitation, Erasure, and Authenticity

Despite its cultural resonance, the choti industry faces acute ethical challenges. The informal nature of production exposes workers—predominantly women—to low wages, unsafe conditions, and limited rights. In Bangladesh, audits by the International Labour Organization have documented cases of wage theft and excessive overtime in home-based choti workshops, often justified by “flexibility” demands from brands. Authenticity is another contested terrain. As the choti gains global traction, claims of “authentic” origin are frequently obscured. Mass-produced knockoffs flood online marketplaces, diluting the cultural significance and undercutting genuine artisans. This “heritage washing”—where products are marketed as traditional without traceable provenance—undermines trust and erodes value. Moreover, the choti’s symbolic power is often reduced to aesthetic tokenism. In international fashion circuits, it is celebrated as exotic, yet rarely understood in its socio-political depth. This superficial engagement risks flattening a complex cultural artifact into a trend, stripping it of its historical gravity and
