Dr. Lena Andersson, a transport psychologist at KTH Royal Institute of Technology in Stockholm, argues that the exam "represents a paradigm shift: from reactive punishment to proactive risk management." She notes that its strength lies in its adaptive design—constantly updated based on real-world accident data and behavioral science. Yet she cautions: "No algorithm can fully capture the contextual intelligence of a skilled driver navigating a crisis. The exam measures patterns, not wisdom." Similarly, Professor Rajiv Mehta of the Indian Institute of Transport Studies observes that while the exam excels in regulated environments, its transferability to high-risk, low-infrastructure settings remains unproven. "Scale without localization is illusion," he warns. Controversies surrounding the exam have centered on fairness and accessibility.
