Moreover, the notebook catalyzed a broader movement: within two years of its release, over a dozen regional publishers—from India’s Rupa Publications to Brazil’s Editora Moderna—announced plans to develop similar “journey-based” reading systems. This ripple effect underscored a transformation: literacy education was no longer a technical administrative function but a contested terrain of cultural values and cognitive futures. However, not all critiques were uniformly positive. Dr. Margaret Lin, a Stanford literacy scholar, cautioned against overestimating the notebook's transformative potential without systemic reform. To address these concerns, Global Horizons established a “Cultural Advisory Council” composed of local educators, tribal elders, and linguists to co-design content. This participatory model—while time-intensive—has become a benchmark for ethical global publishing, demonstrating that true inclusivity requires relinquishing top-down authority in favor of collaborative authorship. Another risk lies in
