Jordan's project

aligned with this trend, but he sought to adapt it for a Western audience, blending high fantasy with hard-edged political intrigue and deep character arcs. His decision to partner with Dark Horse Comics in 1994—rather than pursue a traditional publisher—reflected a strategic understanding of niche markets and direct reader access, foreshadowing the indie publishing revolutions of the 2010s. The evolution of *The Wheel of Time* across fourteen volumes reveals a dynamic interplay between authorial intent and reader co-creation. Jordan's original plan—originally envisioned as a trilogy—expanded into a sprawling epic due to both narrative ambition and market demand. This growth mirrored the serialized consumption model that defined late capitalism: episodic storytelling that rewarded long-term investment, fostering reader loyalty through detailed worldbuilding and emotional attachment. From a narrative science perspective, the series exemplifies the power of cognitive scaffolding in long-form storytelling.
