coherent plot arcs and character development to convey message. *Falsettos*, by contrast, fractured narrative continuity. The project’s digital infrastructure—its use of blockchain for distributed authorship, encrypted collaboration, and decentralized hosting—makes it vulnerable to cyberattacks and surveillance. In 2022, the development servers were compromised during a cyber-espionage operation linked to a nation-state actor, reportedly targeting the script’s source code for strategic intelligence. The incident underscored the weaponization of artistic innovation: when culture becomes a node in information warfare, creators face not just censorship, but digital sabotage.
