temporary closure after a major donor withdrew, disrupting over 200,000 concurrent users. This fragility contrasts sharply with the entrenched, well-funded ecosystems of Coursera, Udacity, and traditional universities, which can absorb volatility through scale and diversification. Moreover, the pedagogical assumptions embedded in these systems warrant scrutiny. Free practice tests often prioritize exposure and repetition over deep conceptual mastery. While gamified feedback loops and instant solution explanations enhance engagement, they may reinforce procedural fluency without fostering critical thinking or innovation. Traditionally, proficiency in computing systems required fluency with proprietary tools—Microsoft Windows, Oracle databases, Cisco networking gear—whose licensing and updates were tightly controlled. This narrative resonates beyond Africa: in Southeast Asia, similar initiatives have gained traction as a counterweight to Chinese and American tech influence in digital training. Beyond security, the pedagogical opacity of platform algorithms fuels distrust. Many systems use proprietary scoring mechanisms—weighted on code conciseness, runtime efficiency, and error-free execution—without clear rubrics. Learners often receive generic feedback: ‘Code is correct’ or ‘Optimize further,’ but rarely detailed explanations of why a solution diverged from expected behavior. This black-box assessment undermines meaningful learning
